MARCH

Because our payroll periods are every other week, twice a year we encounter a month in which there are three pay periods. March was such a month, therefore our operational shortfall grew to \$10,000. Our mortgage income is higher than the same period last year, however is still below what is needed to make our payment.

The Church Council met on Tuesday, April 16th. A few highlights from their conversation:

- 1) The council continued to engage the book, When Church Stops Working by working through chapter 2. For more details see the May Newsletter.
- 2) Each month the council intends to look at one aspect of our Missional Budget Priorities. In April the council discussed their perspectives on how **LCGS** is providing meaningful engagement in God's word through transforming worship on a weekly basis.
- 3) The council is discerning ways for LCGS to connect to the Lutheran Family Services refugee resettlement program that seeks to kick off this month.
- 4) The council formed a small team to brainstorm names to form a financial review committee to meet our constitutional requirement of an internal audit.
